# Usermanual Enblidstart Pro Birth Pools / La Bassine Birth Pools



# Enblidstart

### Please read the user manual before testing the birth pool prior to labor. It is important to follow the precautions, as it may otherwise affect the deposit.

# Unpacking

- The birth pool should be kept at room temperature for 24 hours before being removed from the storage bag and inflated. This prevents the vinyl from cracking.
- Place the pool on the protective mat on a vacuumed floor. Only move the pool by pulling the protective mat to avoid damaging the pool.
- Do not jump into the birth pool when it is only filled with air, as this puts extra pressure on the material and may cause punctures.

# Filling/Draining water

- Filling: Use ONLY clean tap water and the light-colored hose to ensure the hose remains clean.
- **Draining**: Use the dark-colored hose for emptying the water.

# Testing

Test the birth pool and accessories before labor to ensure everything works as expected.

- Inflate the birth pool and leave it with air for at least 4 hours.
- It is not necessary to fill the pool with water, but if you do, make sure to manually drain the water (e.g., using a pot) to avoid contaminating the pool/liner with dirty water from the water pump.
- Avoid testing with the liner, as it is for single use only.
- When testing with water, fill the birth pool with a maximum of 39°C water up to the "max line," visible on the inside of the pool.
- Make sure the faucet connection fits your water tap. Two connectors are included: the black one fits
  the bathroom faucet. If you need to get water from another source, the connector with the fastening
  strap may work. Otherwise, you can attach a fitting that connects to your faucet on one end and is
  either 1/2", 3/4", or compatible with the connector with the fastening strap on the other end.
- Test the water pump and air pump by simply plugging them into a power outlet.
  - ★ **IMPORTANT**: The heating element must only be turned on when submerged in water to avoid overheating.

Do not use, while in the water.

#### Inflating the Pool

- 1. Open the valve at the bottom of the pool and use the smallest nozzle to fill the base with air.
- 2. Open the front section of the valves on the side so it only receives air, and inflate the pool walls.
  - ★ IMPORTANT: Do not overinflate, as this may cause punctures.

# Liner (for both original and non-original liners)

- 1. Attach the liner to the birthing pool while the sides are still soft.
- 2. Lift it and push out any trapped air between the pool and the liner.
- 3. Fully inflate the birthing pool.

# Draining the pool

- 1. Attach the draining hose to the pump to direct the water into a drain.
- 2. Place the waterpump in the birthing pool and plug it into a power outlet..
  - The lower the draining point, the faster the pool will empty.

#### Cleaning

- 1. **Liner:** Empty the liner using the water pump. Remove the liner, fold it to pour out the remaining water, and dispose of it.
- 2. **Pool:** Wipe the pool inside and out with a damp cloth and unscented soap. Check the folds at the top and bottom edges. Allow the pool to dry completely before repacking.
- 3. **Waterpump:** Open the front and back cover of the waterpump and remove ALL residues. Rinse the pump thoroughly with water and unscented soap.
- 4. **The drainage hose:** Clean it with water and unscented soap by pumping soapy water through it (do not use boiling water as it may damage the pump).
- 5. **The filling hose:** Wipe it with a damp cloth and unscented soap, or wash it under running water.
- 6. **Accessories:** Wipe the faucet connectors, air pump, protective mat and manual with a damp cloth and unscented soap.
- 7. Sieve: Rinse the sieve and then pour boiling water over it.
- 8. Additional accessories: Ensure all accessories are clean and dry before returning them.

# **Deflating the Pool**

- 1. Unscrew the black valve on the side to let the air escape naturally.
- 2. Open the bottom valve and use the pump with the smallest nozzle to deflate the base.
- 3. Use the pump to fully deflate the sides. Avoid pressing on the pool.

# Repacking

- 1. Carefully fold the birthing pool on both sides towards the center, then fold it in half (3-4 folds in total).
- 2. Roll up the birthing pool along its long side and place it in the storage bag.
- 3. Fold the hoses without bending them to avoid damage and place them in bags.
  - ★ **IMPORTANT:** Make sure the birthing pool and accessories are completely dry and free of water before packing them away.
